PRESIDENT'S PAGE

5 January 2011

Dear Friends

Our thoughts and prayers go to all our members, friends and communities that have been affected by the recent (and still ongoing) floods throughout Queensland and Northern NSW. While it appears that in many areas the waters are subsiding and clean up has begun, there is still a long road of recovery for these communities as they clean out and rebuild their houses, businesses and assess the damage to crops, livestock and property.

Congregation news

Unfortunately a lot of our farmers have been affected. The full extent of the damage, not only to crops and livestock but also to fences and machinery, is not yet known and will not be properly known for some time yet.

Chinchilla and Bundaberg. The waters are receding in these places and clean up has begun. While farms and crops have been heavily affected in these areas, the main towns have come through with relatively little damage. Bundaberg has suffered with power cuts, some areas not having power for three days.

Rockhampton. We know of one family that has been flood affected & evacuated. There is still more water expected in the area and Rockhampton could remain isolated for up a fortnight.

It was encouraging to hear from each of the pastors and chairmen in the congregations that I spoke to how well the community was pulling together to help each other in any way possible, from the simple matter of washing clothes and toys in clean water, to helping clear out soiled carpets and furniture from affected houses.

How can you help?

There are two funds available that you can direct monies to for helping those who require assistance, the LCA Disaster and Welfare Fund, and the LCAQD Disaster and Relief Fund. Both funds have been established to help those affected by disasters and any donations are tax deductable.
