

Verse for the Week

"Jesus said, 'Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.' And with that he breathed on them and said, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of anyone, their sins are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven'." John 20:21-23

Character Conversation Questions

How have you been a role-model for Jesus; reflecting his new life? How have you been using Jesus gift of forgiveness? Who needs your forgiveness, who do you need to ask? Is it wasted? Are you seeking to listen to the Holy Spirit as you seek to live the new life you have in Jesus?
