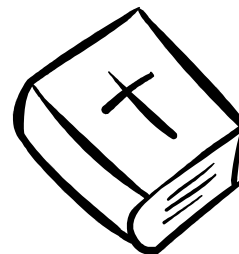

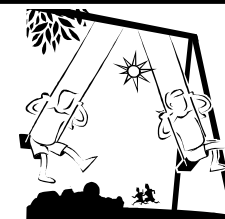

Their new Organ comprises 2 Manual, 32 note Pedal, 28 stops, all connected on the console with 4 tonal Suites – Baroque, French Romantic, English Cathedral, American Classic. In addition, the organist is able to select from 256 additional pipe organ and special effect sounds using the latest in digital technology.

“We are already beginning to realise the potential of this amazing instrument, the first in the Southern Hemisphere with this particular technology.

Immediately our team of organists has increased, there is variety in worship music styles, and young piano students are being inspired to play the organ”, said organist and choir director, Rosalie Turner.

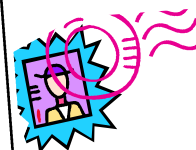
