**Kairos** is a local community-based Christian ministry that serves both those in prison and the families and friends of those in prison.

**WAYS YOU CAN HELP SUPPORT!!**

- 1 Provide Biscuits / slices—please place biscuits in cleaned ice cream containers and write the amount and type of biscuits that are inside, on the lid for identification. Please do not use "snap lock" bags. Decorated biscuits are very sought after, but remember no "sprinkled on" or "rolled in" icing sugar as that could be seen to be a contraband item, but the biscuits can be iced. (Prison Requirement) Any dried fruit should be chopped up finely. (Prison Requirement) Please no nuts in any biscuits due to possible nut allergies. Individually wrapped chocolates (E.G. Cadbury Roses) are very welcome as they are used in the "Forgiveness baskets."
- 2 Make Place mats –maybe with your favourite Bible verse
- 3 Write letters of encouragement (A5 size) -these need to be in groups of 24- (maybe a home/small group could do this—each member could do 3 or 4)
- 4 Prayer Vigil— sign up online—prayer vigil community selection & follow the prompts (if you don't have a computer you are welcome to come into the office and sign up there.)

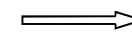
