GOING OUT

Sunday 29th September

As we seek to follow Jesus, as his disciples, we'll be practicing going out by going to Sturt Reserve for a sausage sizzle hosted by all of us.

This gives us the opportunity to invite another person; either prior or after service as we encounter people at Sturt Reserve, or on our walk down.

We will start with a COMBINED SERVICE at 9am. Gathering together in praise of God, and then together inviting people to Jesus' feast—Sausage Sizzle this time. We will have coffee and fellowship as usual after the service and aim to be at Sturt Reserve by 11:30am.

WHY? We're doing this as an act of discipleship. Jesus sent his disciples out to tell other people about him that they might come to know him. So we are using this time to practice going out, so as we go out each day of the week we are reminded to be ready to give a reason for the faith we each have in Jesus when asked.
