Callington Show Sunday 25-10-15 – Fundraising Stall - Damadi – Myanmar.

The past three years a faithful, well organised group of people from Christ-church/Monarto congregations have run a stall at the Callington Show selling various food items including cakes, slices, biscuits and sandwiches. Hot and cold drinks are sold to wash it down. A display and information on Damadi Home Myanmar was set up for people to view and ask further questions. Our stall is part of the Callington Show trail for children which helps bring people and Christian tracts are handed out to the children. After setting up the stall the stall volunteers gathered and prayed together for God's blessing on the day and in particular to calm the winds. God's answered our prayers with the wind easing markedly for about 4 – 5 hours and almost all our produce was sold with a record amount of tea/coffee being purchased this year. A total of **\$1453.70** AUD was raised to support Damadi Home (Centre) in Yangon Myanmar which is an excellent result.
