





March 6th AGM Update

- 51 attended, thank you to everyone who came along
- God has blessed us greatly here at Christ Church, & even though we finished with a small deficit in 2015, our income was \$18,500 above the budgeted figure which allowed additional expenditure as outlined in the 2015 Finance Report.
- Concern was voiced over the lack of money that is spent out of our Church funds on Mission & Outreach.
- As a Church community we felt moved to step out in faith seeking to grow our Mission & Outreach. As a community of faith, all around us we have people who don't know Father's love & Jesus act of Salvation in their life, it's our wonderful privilege as citizens of heaven to make this known to them, what a wonderful opportunity.
- An extra \$25,000 was adopted into the budget for sharing the good news (mission) with this inclusion our deficit is now \$32,000. Now is the chance to step out in faith, listening to where the spirit leads us.
- We will be prayerfully considering the use of the vacant land behind the tennis courts
- Pew cushions will be trialled before making them for all pews. This will be funded by the Service Guild.

creative response

In Sunday's Gospel reading we hear that Mary (sister of Martha and Lazarus) anointed Jesus' feet with nard, a very expensive perfume imported all the way from the Himalayas. Nard was used to prepare bodies for burial. By anointing Jesus, Mary was pointing forward to his sufferings and death soon thereafter.

As part of your home devotion times this week, anoint one another's hands or forehead with perfume or oil. Say together this prayer:

"(Name) I anoint you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that he may strengthen you in all that you do. Amen."

Mary surprised Jesus with a special gift of love. Prepare a special gift of love for a friend, neighbour or relative (money need not be spent).



VIOLET (or Purple) is the color of royalty, repentance, and self-discipline. VIOLET (or Purple) is the traditional color for the season of Lent. This deep rich color somberness, penitence, and prayer. It is a time when we re-orientate our lives towards God, both as individuals and as a community, we look inward and reflect on our readiness to follow Jesus in his journey towards the cross.
