Myanmar News Update - Damadi Centre New Children Needing Sponsorship

In recent emails from Pastor Martin, Lutheran Church of Myanmar he has advised us that Damadi Centre has received 8 new children who need the care and love of the staff at Damadi. Asia Focus Australia (AFA) has been asked to find sponsors for the new children. The children range in age from 5 years to 8 years and come to Damadi as they are not able to be cared for by their families due to poor health, marital problems and death. The cost to sponsor a child is \$650 p.a. which is just over \$54-00 per month and provides for the child's education, living expenses and medical care. All money paid for sponsorship goes to Damadi Centre for the child. AFA, has no admin costs as all people involved are volunteers including Pastor August the CEO. Information is provided on Damadi via newsletters from the Myanmar SA committee and official AFA magazine FIRE.




