Please join us for a cuppa and a biscuit between services.





What happened to teachers in Lutheran schools in June 1917?

The greatest blow to the Australian Lutheran Church in World War I was the closure of its SA schools. Some were reestablished within a decade, and today the sector flourishes. But what became of the 50 teachers who lost their positions on 30 June 1917? 
From the Leadership Team


Share this week's blessing (below) or make up your own.
