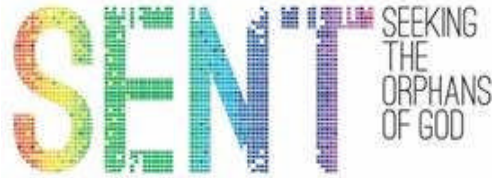
From the Leadership Team

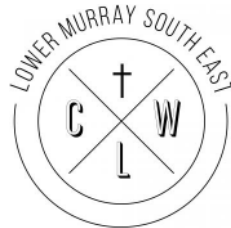
