





Myanmar Update - Rohingya Uprising - Ethnic cleansing

Pastor James, Myanmar Lutheran Church is in much better health. Thank you for your prayers.

Sadly, just south of Paletwa (Chin State) after an uprising of the Rohingya Muslim people the response by the local Arakan people (Budhahists) in Rahkine State has been horrific and a classic example of ethnic cleansing. Many international aid agencies, including Asia Focus Aust (AFA) - Pastor August, have loudly condemned the violence and slaughter of innocent Rohingya people. As a result approx 400,000 people have fled west in to neighbouring Bangladesh. Aung San Suu Kyi on Wednesday 20-9-17 has

finally spoken out saying that the policy of the Myanmar government is for all people to have the right to live in peace regardless of religion, race or ethnic background.

The Khumi people in southern Chin state are at risk of collateral damage and are affected to some extent. As Christians we need to pray for this situation. It is not morally right for people to have their homes burnt and families killed because they are of a different faith. Many aid agencies such as Medicins San Frontieres (Medical) are in the area and have also had field hospitals destroyed by local tribal people (Arakan) with little protection or support from Myanmar's military. If you want to support appeals for financial assistance international aid agencies are seeking help such as Medicins San Frontieres. At this time there is no specific appeal by AFA.

We ask the question. How would you feel if your home was burnt and family members killed and injured because you are a Christian ??? Ian & Dianne Kluge
