

### THE ADVENT WREATH

The Advent wreath is a prominent symbol of the Advent Season. It is usually made up of evergreen branches (representing Life, immortality) placed in a circle (representing eternity of God). Set on the branches are four candles (four weeks of Advent): three purple candles and one pink candle, and a white candle in the centre (see below for each candle). As a whole, these candles represent the coming of the light of Christ into the world. We use the Advent wreath as a way to prayerfully reflect the passage of the Advent season, each candle representing an aspect of the spiritual preparation for the coming of the Lord, Jesus Christ.

1st Sunday – Candle of HOPE (purple)

2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday – Candle of **LOVE** (purple)

3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday – Candle of JOY (pink)

4th Sunday – Candle of **PEACE** (purple)

Christmas – Candle of CHRIST (white)

projects such as aged care, and providing Christmas gifts to the Christian families remaining in Gaza.


