Relationships grow through conversation:

Listening, Talking, Sharing, Asking.

Commitment and Loyalty are bedrock.

We grow by doing it, by living it.

- Choose a regular time and place.
- Read the bible seeking to hear Jesus.
- Jot down thoughts that come to you and reflect on how to be living it.
- Talk with Jesus about your life; asking questions, sharing hopes and dreams, joys and sorrows.
- Be aware of thoughts, ideas, impressions, pictures, feelings, words that come to you.
- Grab the very first thought and go for it. Why wouldn't it be God!!!







Use the SOAP plan.

- S—Scripture Read and Reflect on the bible
- O—Observations. Jot down the main thought or text you get.
- A—Apply it. Take that main thought and invite Jesus to show you how to live it, then go and do it.
- P— Prayer. Take time to talk with Jesus about the text, what it means how to live it. Take time to listen. Invite Jesus to send the Spirit to reveal what he's thinking; listen. Grab the first thought and trust it is Jesus—the second thought is probably someone else!

Find a quiet place, just you and Jesus, and invite him to talk. Then listen and respond. A nice place outside, by the fire, in a quiet room, just a place you can hear Jesus. Begin by asking Jesus to send the Spirit, and that you're open to hear.

Look up a bible reading on Youtube. Jot down the thoughts and feelings that come to you. Enjoy, have fun with Jesus.

Watch part of a Gospel story on Youtube.

On Youtube listen to some Christian music; any style. Enjoy it. Reflect on it. Why not jot down your own song in response.
