Gathering in the Hall July 2020

Part of the process to return to worship has involved submitting a **COVID Safe Plan** to the State Government on how we will manage attendance at Church and other areas of our facilities. Copies can be found displayed in the Church, the Hall and the Office.

It is especially important that we all follow this plan and the procedures and direction given to you, when attending Church or other activities.

Anyone who is feeling unwell, will not be allowed to attend the service. While this may sound harsh, it is important that we ALL follow the current procedures. If you wake up and are feeling unwell on the day, you MUST NOT ATTEND the service.

Social distancing (1.5m) is to be observed on all of the church premises, especially on entering buildings and when inside buildings. **Reminder that there is to be no handshakes or hugs**.

We may have up to 143 people in the hall, only if it is required we can livestream the service into the Church

Requirements from our COVID Safe Plan

Tea & Coffee: please bring your own ready made tea & coffee, Kitchen will be closed

When you arrive you must use the hand sanitiser

We are required to keep a record of the names and contact details of all attending the service. You will need to sign in with your name and contact phone number before you enter the hall.

Chairs have been set out at appropriate distancing. Households may move their chairs closer together otherwise they are not to be moved.

The offering will be a retiring offering

At the conclusion of the service we are required to disinfect the frequently touched surfaces, including chair backs, door handles, railings, offering baskets, toilet facilities and any other surfaces that may have been touched by multiple people.
