## Retiring offerings during the month of April for Myanmar Mission

**Myanmar Mission Update No 3** Civil Unrest and Violence Continues

The situation in Myanmar continues to worsen with the military becoming more heavy handed. Since the coup on 1st February, over 500 people have been killed and many thousands injured as the military junta, (army & police) have imposed military rule and cracked down on the thousands of protesters in Myanmar. It is alarming to hear that at least 20 children have been killed as the military indiscriminately fire bullets in to people's houses at night. The Burmese army has 1.4 million soldiers which have for many years been used to wield power for the controlling generals over it's own people.

Pastor Martin overnight advised that up in Tahan, (Kalaymyo) in north west Myanmar where Asia Focus works with the Lutheran church protests were held there on Sunday. Sadly, five people were killed and many other injured on Sunday 28th March and this occurred in the Christian area of Tahan. At this time none of the people we are in close contact with or know through our mission trips have been affected in Tahan.

A couple of weeks ago Pastor Moses from Myanmar Lutheran Church whilst out in the local area of Insein, Yangon at night was injured by being shot with rubber bullets mainly to his back.

We must continue to pray for all the people in Myanmar and especially our brothers and sisters over there. Ian & Dianne Kluge



He was murdered by being nailed to a cross. He was taken down and put in a grave in the side of a hill. A massive stone was rolled across the entrance, and darkness took over where Jesus lay. Everyone, Soldiers, Roman Governor, family, followers and friends, thought it was all over. Jesus was dead!

However, as often happens when Jesus is involved, the unexpected happened. Early Sunday morning, friends of Jesus went to the grave. The massive stone was rolled away. The body of Jesus was gone. Then suddenly, He was right there, not recognised until He was standing close and then there was recognition, and light came back into His friend's lives.

As we shine a light on something in the dark, and we get closer and more focused, more detail emerges — same with Jesus.

The difference being, we don't have to work at getting closer to Him. He comes to us and brings with Him forgiveness and a new relationship with Himself and His Heavenly Father, your Heavenly Father (God).

He says, "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me." (Revelations 3:20)

If you are willing to just give Jesus a go at being in your life, He will keep His promise to become part of your life and make a change in your life.

In the Bible, Jesus says, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8:12) Let the light of Jesus love shine and focus on your life; you will see where He can bring light and change to your life.

Are you feeling second rate or picked on? Talk to Jesus about it and be prepared to have the light of His love help you focus on the causes of these feelings and fears. Maybe you would like to show more care to others but are too self-conscious? Ask Jesus to shine a light on your life and help you see the care you may already be spreading around, and thank Him for it.

With the light of Jesus' love shining into our lives, by letting Him get closer and help us focus our lives, we will see in more detail the impact His love can bring. Not only will we see this, but others will see it in us. More love, more joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

Jesus said He would not stay in the grave; He didn't! He said He will bring light into lives. He does! Let His love eliminate the dark areas of your life and LIVE!
