Objective of the Position

To assist in the achievement of Christ Church Lutheran congregation's goals in the provision of financial duties.

Primary responsibilities (Ministry Strategies)

- 1. To undertake financial and accounting duties to maintain accurate financial records including, paying accounts, financial data entry and reporting.
- 2. To meet on a regular basis with the Chairperson and Leadership Team to ensure ongoing clarification of roles, and to work together as a team.
- 3. To Supervise & Co-ordinate along with the appointed person by Leadership the duties undertaken by the bookkeeper, ensuring accurate and correct handling of all work undertaken.

Duties of Position

- a) Attend all Leadership meetings & other meetings as required.
- b) September December Start preparing the Budget for the following year.
- c) Review and prepare Hall & Other hire rates.
- d) Contract Teen Challenge, Hire letters re JDH to Pensioners etc.
- e) Contract Red Cross.
- f) Prepare and send off Monarto Budget for following year.
- g) AGM is in March. Prepare all necessary reports for all accounts for AGM. This will require assistance from Bookkeeper.
- h) After AGM go to ACNC website, log in and enter data from financial reports as needed. Both main a/c and Auxiliaries need to be done.
- i) Prepare and complete Financial figures for LAMP statistical returns.
- j) Counter signing payments for Internet banking or cheques.

BLOWN AROUND

We see them all over the place. Rolly Pollies are blowing across paddocks, caught and stuck against fences. One day blown this way. The next day blown another way. All at the whim of an ever-changing wind. Why?

As the soil in which the plants were rooted has changed, dried and no longer nourishes the plants, they are no longer sustained, and they too become dry and at the mercy of the winds which blow across their world.
