#### Rejoice! There's a Retreat coming!

So many women regretted the absence of a retreat at the beginning of 2021. The good news is that we are planning one for the usual weekend in January, 2022 – but not the usual live-in event. For our first occasion of holding a different kind of retreat, we're using the excellent facilities at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Para Vista.

The retreat will run from Friday evening, January 14 until Saturday evening, January 15. The Friday evening session is 6.30 pm for a 7 pm start, and is due to finish at 9 pm. At the conclusion you can sleep at home, if you live close enough. Or if you make arrangements to stay with relatives or friends who are close enough, you can go to them. Or if you have nobody you can stay with, we have some willing hosts nearby, but we'll need to know your accommodation need by December 15, so that we can make suitable links between hosts and guests. (See enrolment form.)

We are also seeking more suburban hosts within cooee of Para Vista, to make it possible for country or outer metro women to attend. Contact me if you can be a host – just like the good old days of billeting for synods!

Saturday begins with registration at 8.30 am and will conclude at 9 pm. (Same sleeping arrangements as Friday.) The whole day's yummy food will be prepared by the local catering group at Para Vista. They have a weekly ministry, providing meals for the community, so they've had plenty practice!

Total cost for full-time: \$70.

There'll be all the usual benefits that retreats provide: fellowship, spiritual growth, singing, laughter, viewing stalls, buying books, renewing friendships and making new ones, etc. The only thing missing will be the camaraderie of an overnight stay. But that's something you can share over two bed 'n' breakfasts with your host or guest, whether it be a friend, relative or a *new* friend.

We have a great theme: 'Stop, listen, lean on Me.' And I'm sure you know who is meant by the word 'Me' with a capital M! Our chaplain, Pastor Michael Dutschke, will lead some sessions on listening to God. We'll also have input from some women speakers: Karen Pietsch and Kerry Norman.

This time there's no formal Sunday session, so you will be free to worship wherever you wish.

There is a man. Daily he stands looking out from his lounge room window. One day he mutters to himself," I don't know. The view doesn't appear as clear as it once did. He shrugs, closes the curtains and goes back to reading the daily paper.

Then one day, while he is looking through the window, there is a knock on the door. He closes the curtains. On opening the door, standing on the doorstep is a very good friend. He invites his friend in for a cup of coffee and wanders off to turn on the kettle. His friend, standing in the lounge room, comments, "Mate, it's a bit dark in here. Mind if I open the curtains?" I know it's pretty big and high, but I can come round and give it a go over." Taking his friend's empty cup and limping toward the sink, the man replies, "Thanks, mate. Don't bother. She'll be right."

There is a man. He stands looking through the now opaque images of life. He notices the "splotch of sadness", steadily growing out from one corner towards the dark memories of "hurt'. In the middle is what was once only a speck. Still, over time, "longing" mixed with "wistfulness" is growing and covering more of the image. Where once the brightness of joy, peace, happiness, fulfilment, all washed through his life, now they struggle to make an impression.

There is a man called Jesus. He stands by the man and says, "I am here to help. I have the power of a loving God. My whole reason for being is to love and support you and all who need my presence. Read about my love through the pages of my story of love. You will find the book in many places, even on the web. It is called "The Bible". Or, you can trust me and my words and just talk to me. You may not see me, but I am here.

Will you accept the help and talk with the one standing by you, even if you cannot see him? You might be surprised how clear life can become.
