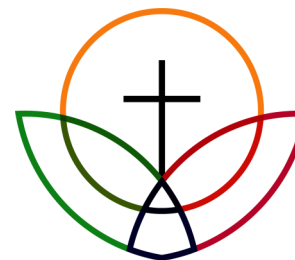

**Welcome to all worshipping with us today**

### **Augsburg on 25 June 1530.**

This Sunday we recognise our foundational confession:

The Augsburg Confession.

This confession was drafted by Luther and others and finally collated and delivered to the Roman Emperor, Charles V, at the Diet of Augsburg, A.D. 1530, by Phillip Melancthon. The Augsburg Confession was intended to be a unifying confession of faith between Roman Catholics and Lutherans in the face of the imminent threat of the Ottoman Empire (Islam). There are 28 articles stating very clearly the Lutheran position on all matters of faith. Eg: Article IV:  
*Justification: We teach that people cannot be justified before God by their own strength, merits or works, but are freely justified for Christ's sake through faith, when they believe that they are received into favour and that their sins are forgiven for Christ's sake, who by His death has made satisfaction for our sins. This faith God accounts as righteousness in His sight. Rom. 3 and 4.*

### **PRAYER:**

- ✠ Pray for the homeless in Murray Bridge and surrounding areas, that they may find shelter, have warmth and food during this cold period.
- ✠ Pray for those who have financial issues, or no work and finding it difficult to face everyday issues.
- ✠ Pray for those living close to the sea in Myanmar and for the Lutheran Church and the people in Rakhine state (Myanmar) and Bangladesh, who have been affected by the Cyclone Mocha, through loss of home, work, clothing, food and safety .
