Today Jonah reveals how 'unfair' and 'underserved' God's grace really is. He insisted that the Ninevites should not hear about God's grace because they didn't deserve it, after all Nineveh was known as "the city of blood". Jonah's selfishness reveals 2 things about our God.

Nobody deserved God's love and grace. Grace literally means 'undeserved love'.

Jonah also knew the power of God's word to transform lives. He did not want to share God's word with the Ninevites because he knew the message could change their lives, as it did so dramatically. He thought they were unworthy to have their lives changed – God had other ideas.
