Why did the people of Meribah, a small town in the South Australian Mallee, call their town Meribah. Our reading mentions a place called Meribah. God's people were on the way to the Promised Land and discovered they had no water. They complained bitterly to God. Their complaints hinted that they were better off in slavery in Egypt. God gave them water. But was water the real issue? God called this place Massah and Meribah because the Israelites quarrelled and because they tested the LORD saying, "is the LORD among us or not?" (Ezekiel 17:6,7). Please know the Lord is among us in many ways. He is with us broadly in the love of another Christian, he is with us very specifically where his word is spoken and enacted in the sacraments, in worship. Immanuel = he is with us. We learn that our complaints about this or that can be understood by God as our doubt, as us saying, "is the Lord amongst us or not?" Jeff and Fran Henschke can tell us why Meribah is Meribah. They are not complaining people like the Israelites. Was it simply named after the abundance of water found in the Mallee desert? Ask Jeff and Fran. DJK
