Where do you deliberately, repeatedly reset into gospel-mode? Default:

Failure to fulfil an obligation, especially to repay a loan or to appear in a law court.

Revert automatically to a preselected option.

We don't need the story of the Golden Calf to highlight our human default position, sin. If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us (1 John 1:8). Today we hear that Moses the Israelite leader was "up on the mountain with God". The Israelites didn't honour this. They didn't believe this was a good thing for their leader. They complained (as they have done since Egypt): "They gathered around Aaron and said, "Come, make us gods who will go before us. As for this fellow Moses who brought us up out of Egypt, we don't know what has happened to him."

The truth is that our default position is to turn away from God to something or someone else.

Luther teachers that even after you are converted by the gospel your heart will go back to default mode, operating on other principles unless you deliberately, repeatedly set it to gospel-mode. Our worship is the chief place where we deliberately, repeatedly reset into gospel-mode. It's not the only place – where do you deliberately, repeatedly reset into gospel-mode?
