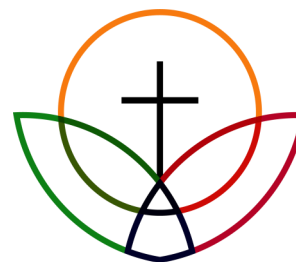

Welcome to all worshipping with us on Reformation Sunday

Can you imagine being groomed by your church to believe that you must earn your way to heaven – in many cases you had to literally pay with gold or silver your way to heaven. This church teaches you in Latin – you do not speak or understand Latin. You faithfully trust the church to translate the core of God's word to you in your language. One day a church teacher says to you that what the church is teaching is wrong. A single man says the church is wrong! This single man defies every religious, political, and military authority to say to you that you are saved for heaven freely thought the sacrifice of Jesus Christ. Would you believe this one man going against the overwhelming majority? You trust this man. You accept his teaching. You now are being persecuted as he is. You now have joined a movement; it is dangerous, exciting, and liberating. At first you are awed by Martin Luther. Very quickly you learn deep in your heart that this movement is not led by Martin Luther but by the Holy Spirit to bring the truth to the church. This movement changes the course of history. This movement was led by the Holy Spirit to reform the church, the Roman Catholic Church. We call this movement the Reformation beginning in 1517 when Martin Luther nailed a list of 95 teachings the church needed to change to be a church of truth. You are now a Lutheran. The rest is history...
