When someone dies, we almost always have regrets.; "I wish I could have spent more time with him"; "I regret what I said".

So long as we are human and make poor choices, we will have regrets. If we hang on to regret, we are in for a long burdensome life. However, regret can be helpful if we identify it as an indicator of something we need to repent of. God wants us to deal with regret.

Regret focuses on the action that has brought sorrow; repentance focuses on the one we have offended. "Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death."2 Cor 7:10

Godly sorrow leads to repentance, "I'm sorry I didn't spend more time with him"; "I repent of what I said". Forgiveness and freedom flow out of repentance.

I repent, "I didn't spend more time with him". I repent, "I didn't bring him that Rotkohl I promised". I repent, "I didn't listen to the words of a wise old pastor more often". We thank God for Pastor Andy's faithful service to his Lord. He was ordained on 10 January 1965 at St Stephen's Adelaide SA.
