Jesus' focus is on the the relationship he daily with you.

Anything that wants to divide my life up is a distortion of reality. The reality is that in Jesus I'm the same person in every situation I find myself in. The goal is to live true to who I am. in Jesus, in every situation.

To lose sight of this is kingdom to fit his to lose myself.

Jesus' goal is that I live authentic in every situation I find myself in, for the situation isn't to define me. Rather who I am in Jesus has the power to shape whatever situation I find myself in. For right there, at that time and place, I can bring Jesus character and personality into that situation. In Jesus you are a world changer, not manipulated and shaped by the events done to you.

That's how Jesus lived; he's never shaped by the events done to him, but as he Jesus said he'd build lives true to who he is his community of in Father, Jesus shapes the world around him. Shapes the world into the

reality of his character and personality. Jesus' kingdom comes, and the king shapes his character and personality, never the other way around.

When Jesus asked his the ultimate symbol disciple; 'Who do people say I am?'

The goal is to live true to who I am, in Jesus, in their slow painful very situation.
