Have you ever tried to love someone who doesn't want to know you? How well does loving I am, it ceases that work; you ring and they never reply,

vou invite them out and they never come. you give of yourself but they stay at arm's length. How well does love work when it is only a one way action?

Love by its very nature seeks to engage the other person. God, in Jesus, gave his life so that we might do what? Ignore him.

If you ignored God would that mean he didn't love you? Or tragic loss; God out in love. but without any response, without any love in return, his love would be lost on us. That is a tragic thought.

Does God love you? In Jesus the answer is an unequivocal ves. There is no

shadow of doubt. in Jesus. God loves vou.

That's what we just read: Jesus has sacrificed his life for us. It is a done deal. Jesus has, not might, but has sacrifice his life for vou. That's God's love in action.

Actually God doesn't know how to act in any other way. for John also told us: 'God is love' (1 Jn. 4:16b) God doesn't love. in the sense that it is iust one of his many attributes. it is simply a living expression of who he is. Whatever God does. whatever Jesus does. whatever the Spirit does is love. for that is their nature. their character, their very heart beat. And God always acts true to who he is.

Now if you don't want forgiven, set free to Jesus' love, it won't be forced on vou. Have you noticed, vou can't force another person to love you? Actually

I've noticed that the harder I try, the more I push. the further away they go. Forcing someone to love vou just doesn't seem to work: have you ever experienced please. You are that?

Neither does working hard to get someone to like vou. Then vou've trapped

vourself in a lie. where vou've aot to keep working hard, or relationship with me, they might discover the real you and that could be the end of things.
