That makes me think of a story Jesus told, about ten girls waiting for the bridegroom to arrive. Five took extra oil for their lamps and five didn't. Guess what happened: the bridegroom was late, ran out. When he arrived the five with extra oil were prepared. relationship that he the other five went off to buy oil and missed come back to find the door locked, and to hear these words: 'I don't know you. Go away.'
