Emmaus told their story of how Jesus has appeared to them as they walked along the road, and how they had was breaking the bread." (Luke 24:35)

Jesus is walking and talking with you along the way: invite him to reveal himself to you in what you are doing, in the people you meet, through the circumstances vou find vourself in. Invite Jesus to open vour heart and mind to recognise Jesus, and then share that walk with those you meet. Share what vou and Jesus talked about. In doing so you'll be helping others recognise Jesus in their day.

I invite you now to take time to pray. Thank Jesus for walking with you, and

recall with him some of your day, and invite him to reveal how you was there.

Take your time; isn't it wonderful none of us have got anything else to rush off to!!!

Take your time and enjoy recognising Jesus. Enjoy walking and talking with Jesus in all of life. Remember Jesus is present and interested in everything you do: from your gardening. your work, your family, your hobbies,

your sorrows, your iovs. He come to share himself daily with you; walking and talking with you.

Today we're going to look at one of the accounts of the risen dashed. Jesus was Jesus.

What high hopes they had. Only to be crucified and now body is missing. I taste of this: having relate to how these disciples would have been feeling.

and dreams gone? Was Jesus gone?

Here they are walking and talking with Jesus but don't recognise him. Actually the whole time they were with Jesus, the last three years, they didn't really see who he was. They'd seen Jesus through the lens of what they wanted to happen rather than seeing themselves through Jesus' eyes.

That got me reflecting on what could be stopping me Jesus? What might be stopping you from guess we've all had a recognising Jesus in your daily life?

> Is Jesus alive and well? Of course, Is Jesus seeking to interact with you daily, maybe even walking and talking with you? Is Jesus walking and talking with us in this season of the COVID virus?

What might be stopping me from recognising him?

As I was pondering this I was reading Jesus life story as recorded by Matthew; Matthew chapter 9. Here I encountered people who recognised Jesus and people who didn't.

People brought a paralysed man to Jesus. "Seeing their FAITH, Jesus said to the paralysed man, 'Be encouraged, my child! Your sins are forgiven." (Matt. 9:2)

FAITH is the key word, these people come trusting Jesus. They come placing their hope in Jesus. These people come to who? Jesus! Thev come placing their life in Jesus' hands.

In this story there's another group of people: "But some of the teachers of religious law said to themselves, 'That's blasphemy! Does he think he's God?" (Matt. 9:3)

These people, even though they are hoping for the Messiah, don't recognise him. He's there, talking to them, but they don't recognise him. Jesus doesn't fit their ideas of what is meant to

happen, so they reject him.

This scenario is played out throughout Jesus life story; there are two groups, those who are open, seeking, emptying themselves. That's the people of faith. And those full of themselves.

interpreting everything through what they think is possible, according to their ideas. They're Jesus is inviting you the ones who miss Jesus, the very Messiah they are looking for. The very answer to their hopes and dreams.

Isn't that a tragedy.

Jesus is inviting you to come walk and talk with him, seeing life through his eyes. I love the thought of living in Jesus' hopes and dreams.

Jesus revealed to these two followers how the bible had told what would happen to the Messiah. How he would suffer and die. and on the third day rise again. And that is exactly what happened. Jesus track record is good: he can be trusted.

- He's done what was revealed trust with your life; his promises come true. He has the power and authority to do what

to trust him, to see your life through his eyes, letting him call the shots. Jesus invites you to come walking and talking with him as he makes sense of COVID19, as he leads you into life beyond your wildest dreams.

Today, the risen Lord Jesus, seeks to walk with you, to talk with you, to share his life

with you. To invite you to be part of his hopes and dreams for life, for the future. Jesus risked talking Today you're invited.

And there is one simple way to accept that invitation; take Jesus at his word. Become vulnerable, trusting what Jesus says is true, will happen. Empty yourselves of your own ideas of what is possible and accept Jesus for who he savs he is. Look at life, at vourself through Jesus eyes, letting him shape who you are and the reality vou live in.

Then begin walking and talking with him. Begin asking Jesus, seeking to listen to his opinions above everything.
