with us what is on his heart right now.

Jesus we now invite you to send Spirit to show us what is on your heart and soul. We invite you to speak. We are keen to know your thoughts, to know you, to grow in greater intimacy with you. Send Spirit and speak with us now.

Grab that first thought, idea, impression, sense, colour, name, feeling being open and expectant that Jesus does because he's passionate want to be real to you. That he has sent Spirit so that we can know him. follow him, be open to his leading in how we live and what we do.

Jot down what you receive. Mull it over. Ask question. You're in a conversation.

Do be aware of that second thought. Guess who that is? The devil, and his one goal it to cast doubt. 'Don't believe Jesus can communicate with you, after all who do you think you are!'

Of course Jesus is interested in you: he's given his life quite literally to be in this living relationship of love and affection.

Jot down your thoughts, not as though you're some holy oracle and everyone has to do what you say. Jesus hasn't invite us to lord it over other people: he's come to speak to our hearts about living out that intimate relationship he created.

Finally, you may feel you need prayer or would just like to be prayed for. I invite the people with you to ask Spirit to reveal what Jesus has for you. Take time to ask Jesus; grab that first thought and share it with the person being prayed for.

Don't try to interpret it, just share what you have Talk to him today. been given, whether it

makes sense or not. I'm sure Jesus knows what to sav.

Take what he has given. Talk it over with him. Test it with his clear word. But most of all seek to live it out.

Isn't that what relationships are for; LIVING?

Today I encourage you not to talk about the Spirit, but to talk with Spirit, inviting him into every area of your life, so that in all you do vou're walking and talking with Jesus. That's his passion, to share his life intimately with you. To share your greatest joy or sorrow right down to the frustration vou have when losing the remote control.

Jesus wants to be involved in everything. He wants you involved in his life, all aspects.

Acts 2:1-21

What does it take to build a car? There is planning, then construction. It is an involved process. It takes time and effort. When the car roles off the production line, what's the next step?

Where am I going with this? Well I see that God has invested himself in humanity. He's created us. He has been born our lounge room, just to look did? So how do we live life right now?

Over the next weeks I want to be looking at how we live out this life So Jesus sends the Spirit; with Jesus. Actually I

'look' I want to be 'doing' it.

Often on 'Pentecost' Sunday I've talked about So let's do that now. standing there admiring my prized car, talking about it's features, it's power, it's beauty.

We could stand there all day talking and admiring love and affection with my prized car, but what I you, in a conversational really want to do is drive it.

So today I could talk to you about the Spirit. I could tell you that he is the comforter, the bringer of peace, God with us right now. I could quote the prophet Joel as Peter did on that first Pentecost; talking about your sons and daughters prophesying. Your young men seeing dreaming dreams (Acts 2:17-21). I could talk about it, but what would you rather; talking about the Spirit or talking to the Spirit. Talking about it, or doing it.

I don't think Jesus gave his life for us that we endlessly talk about it. I think Jesus gave his life for us that we endlessly

atmosphere, quite naturally living out your supernatural love. We ask that you send the Spirit to be with us now. that as we spend this time with you we are aware of your love for visions and your old men us, attuned to hear your voice, ready to be walking and talking with Spirit those hurts in your you. Thank you that you didn't just come to talk about things incessantly, but that you came that we might talk with you endlessly, hearing from you, following you in all of life. Jesus we are open, our desire is to live hurts, those needs, those out this relationship, right now.

One of the symbols of the Spirit's presence is that of fire. In the Bible we are told that God is a consuming fire (Hebrews 12:29 – 'For our God is a consuming fire.'). I like the image of God's wrath burning up the rubbish in my life.

One of the things the Spirit does is to bring comfort to our troubled

> conscience. We are able to bring our hurts, our mistakes, our need for forgiveness to Jesus through the Spirit.

And when we confess our sin: from the heart, what is Jesus response? He forgives. He heals. He empowers us to overcome and live out his love, his character in our lives.

I invite you now to pause and bring to the life. Take time to jot them down. I invite you to pause and jot down where you need forgiveness. Who do you need to forgive? Invite the Spirit to lead you, as you seek to bring those regrets, those mistakes done to others, bring

them to Jesus asking for that you might be living his forgiveness.

Now forgiveness isn't saving what you did or was done to you doesn't that we live from his matter. It's not 'You can loving presence; being just forget it'. That's not his loving presence in all He's given his life that forgiveness. Forgiveness of life. is bringing those hurts those things you've done Another quality of fire is You can expect Jesus to that hurt, to Jesus, that you might be living and breathing his loving presence into your life, into the people you meet.

I don't want my mistakes or the hurts done to me to shape me. So I bring them to Jesus seeking his forgiveness.

Take a few moments now to jot down the incidences that have come to your mind and ask Jesus, through the Spirit, to forgive you.

In your mind place these hurts, these mistakes. these regrets into God's all consuming fire, that he might cleans and heal you. Enjoy the release. Invite Jesus to embrace you in his forgiving love. Repent, letting the Spirit remove the rubbish from your life,

life in all Jesus fullness.

When you talk with him, grab those first thoughts and go with it. Enter the conversation and be living the reality.
