At Jimmy's worst he would get on stage, drunk, and forget the words to his songs. Mary would slide up behind him and whisper the words in his ear.

If you listen carefully to his songs you can hear her whispering the words to him.

She wanted the best for him – she didn't want him to look stupid on stage. For over 20 years she carried him – she was his advocate.

She would write for him because he couldn't write.

She would speak for him when he couldn't speak.

She would whisper to him when he couldn't remember.

She always stood behind him - nodding.

But here's the thing – He made a promise to love her – but he failed over and over.

She made a promise to love him and stand by his side always – look she was human, but you can see **beautifully and clearly** in the worst of times she was there – standing behind him.

The perfect advocate - reminding him that he was loved, that he was a great musician, that he could do good with his music.

He didn't deserve her love – she promised him her love.

He died one night after a gig – like most musicians he became more famous dead than alive.

Mary never left him.

I'm not sure if it does it for you – but The Holy Spirit is my Mary – my advocate – quietly standing behind me – reminding me – whispering to me: You are a child of God - he forgives you – He loves you – no matter what dark state I am in.

We all have voted 1 for Jesus.

Listen to Isaiah 30 – wow if this is not the Jimmy Reed story – if this is not or a prophecy of our Holy Spirit's advocacy– well I don't know what.

*"You are obstinate people,"
declares the LORD...*

you are rebellious, deceitful , and unwilling to listen to the MY instruction.

*You say, "Don't give us any more Godly visions of what is right!
Only Tell us things which please us – give us Illusions not visions.*
