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As you do so, you are to serve as an example of Christian conduct, by earnestly endeavouring to live in brotherly unity with your people and fellow workers and sister congregations, stimulating and encouraging them to support the work of the Lutheran Church of Australia.

Of course, all this is only possible when we <u>all</u> serve the one true creator God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The only way the **Murray Valley Lutheran Community**, and Pastor Paul and I include Pastor David in this as well, is to keep moving forward, to keep living as those who have been made alive in Christ Jesus, and setting your hearts on things above.

Colossians 3:1-4, Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.² Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.³ For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.⁴ When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

This happens because Jesus is the whole Gospel, and the whole contradiction of all the misrepresentations of the Gospel (Colossians 1:15-2:23). Paul says in his first chapter to the **Colossians**, we have this assurance because of who Christ is; He is the image of the invisible God. **The Creator**, the one who is unparalleled over all things.

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What's that saying, **"2 is company 3 is a crowd"** Well, in your circumstances 3 congregations have now become one **Community**, One in Christ Jesus.

- Christ,
- Lord,
- Lord Jesus,
- Lord Christ.

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The distinction which follows, between things "above" and things "on earth," is consequently grounded in the fact that Christ-as-Lord is both the centre and the whole of the Christian life.

So, Pastor Paul, as you set your ministry on the things above, and not on earthly things, where moth and grub destroy. May God the Father who raised our Lord Jesus Christ, keep your heart and mind focused on Christ alone, so that **"When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.**

And in the words of one of our loved Sem Lecturers **Dr. Dean Zweck**, who when he had finished teaching every class, would leave us with these words. **"Go in peace and serve the Lord"** Amen.

Prayer – Lord, since we have been raised with Christ, continue to set our hearts on the things above, and not earthly things, so that when Christ appears in Glory, we too may appear with him in his glory. Through Christ our Lord. Amen

Grace and peace to you from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

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Prayer: Father, may the words of my mouth and the meditation of our hearts be acceptable in your sight O Lord, our rock and our redeemer. Amen.

Now, are you bleary-eyed and feeling a bit dusty this morning? If you are, maybe it's because you have been staying up late to watch the Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games. Perhaps as you sit here this morning, your mind is wandering back to the opening ceremony, of music and dance and the 4-meter-high puppets, the sound of the band Duran Duran, and let's not forget the 10-meter-tall mechanical bull, along with more than 5,000 athletes who will be competing over the next 2 weeks.

Ahh – the Challenge to stay focused.

Martin Luther once challenged one of his students by saying, "I'll get you a new horse and carriage if you can pray the Lord's Prayer and concentrate on every phrase without losing your train of thought." The young man thought, "no problem." After he had prayed the prayer, he however confessed to Luther, "all I could think about was the horse and carriage." As much as he tried to concentrate on the Lord's Prayer, his mind was drawn elsewhere.

His mind was drawn to the worldly sense of what he might get... "something for nothing" on the things below.

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Today for all of you, marks another step forward in completing the final stages of your new entity in the body of Christ. Through many years and months of negotiations between Monarto Zion, Christ Church, and Holy Cross Lutheran Churches, you have seen the fruition of unity come to be, and have now formed the **Murray Valley Lutheran Community**. You could say the old has gone and the new is here!

Of course, where there is change, there can also be uncertainty. **How will it work?** <u>Will it</u> <u>last?</u> <u>How many services will each Church get?</u> **What about the money?** Will we need to have a different account? And the all-important question... who will be our pastors?

You have the responsibility in accordance with the call document to give Pastor Paul the love, respect, and goodwill that is ascribed to him as your called and ordained, servant of the Word. You are to promise to be diligent and faithfully assist in his prayerful support, and at the same time, you are to seek his counsel and aid for your spiritual welfare and cooperate in Pastor Paul's endeavours to care for you, including pastoral visits to your homes.

You are to partner with Pastor Paul, cooperating with him in endeavouring to extend the ministry of the Word – that means that it is not only his job but yours as well, to care for all people who are under the spiritual care, of your congregation and in the wider community.

Furthermore, you are to obligate yourselves to make faithful and regular use of the means of grace, that is **Word and Sacrament**, so that God's enabling power may have free course among each and every one of you, so then you can carry out your God-given ministry, to the service and glory of God, and to the welfare of all, and support the work of the Lutheran Church of Australia.

You are also to receive Pastor Paul as your brother in Christ Jesus, and provide him, and his family, with love and care, promising your support for their welfare, physically, emotionally, and spiritually. You are to commit yourselves to the regular evaluation of the ministry and mission of your community, **Murray Valley Lutheran Community**, which also includes your <u>own role</u> in that mission and ministry.

Additionally, you are to provide Pastor Paul with proper maintenance according to your ability, and to annually review, his salary, housing arrangements, and all allowances.

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
