The Murray Valley Lutheran Community has a new membership database. Please let us know if your address/phone number or email address has changed in the last couple of years so we can update our records to reflect this. Please provide us with an updated photo or come into either office and we can take one. If you would like to check your details are correct please contact us at the offices.

Working with Children Checks (WWCCs) were introduced in July 2019 and are valid for 5 years. This now means that checks issued in 2019 will start to expire this year. Check the expiry date for your WWCC; you can update your check up to 6 months before it expires. Clearances can take up to 6 weeks to be issued to you. LCA recommend applying at least 2 months prior to the expiry date. WWCC application forms to update your check are available from the offices. Please remember that any volunteer or employee without a valid WWCC must step down from their role until they obtain a valid clearance.


anniversary of the opening of the current church building. A Centenary Committee has been formed, however we are looking for more people who would be interested in helping to organise both these special occasions.

THE POWER OF PRAYER On June 13th 2013 our Grandson Daniel aged 18 had a horrific road accident resulting in life threatening injuries. He was airlifted to the RAH. His brain injury was so severe Drs reports repeatedly said he couldn't possibly survive and In the unlikely

chance he did, he would be institutionalised for the rest of his life. Two days after the accident while his family were all totally devastated his Dad Russell (our son) said we are going to pray and thank God for Daniel's healing and in months we will be on the stage in the Golden Grove Lutheran Church giving his testimony. With the power of prayer chains, locally, publicly and in Churches interstate and worldwide, 7 months later a large audience attended to witness Daniel's testimony and

recovery. In the meantime he was on Life Support in ICU for 3 weeks, then in rehabilitation for 6 months receiving speech therapy, physio and to relearn walking, speaking & communication skills. He has since completed his Certificate 3 and presently works for "Just Living" as a Disability Support Worker. Daniel married lovely Nicole in 2024 in the Para Vista Lutheran Church and is waiting for their Fairmont Home to be completed in 2025. God is Good! Joyce Herrmann.



Maxine finds joy in music



For more than 40 years, Resthaven Murray Bridge resident, Mrs Maxine Gogler, 86, played the pipe organ at the Holy Cross Lutheran Church at Murray Bridge. 'The sounds you can get from it are thrilling,' Maxine says. 'From the softest whisper to the loudest roar, the organ lets you play with an emotion and range that not many other instruments have.' Built by Fincham of Melbourne in 1927, the Holy Cross' organ was originally made for the Christ Church Anglican Cathedral, Ballarat, Victoria, for the sum of \$4,800. In 1980, the electro-pneumatic organ was purchased by Holy Cross at Murray Bridge. With little work done on it since its creation, the organ was refurbished and rebuilt in Adelaide by Mr George Stephens and a dedication ceremony was held at Holy Cross on

Sunday, 21 February 1982. When the organ was first installed at Holy Cross, there was no one there who could play it properly - after all, the organ has over 1,000 pipes and some of the wooden ones, made from Californian Redwood, are more than 16 foot long. To properly do it justice. Maxine took it upon herself to take lessons in Adelaide with James Thiele at the Lutheran Church in Flinders Street. 'He was an excellent organist,' Maxine says. 'One of the best, and he taught me so much. Playing the organ is not the same as playing piano or keyboard, you really do need to learn how to play it properly.' Before she found her true love in the organ, Maxine began by learning the piano. Growing up in the house next door to the Holy Cross Church, she was allowed to play the piano there. 'I took lessons with Mrs Blake up the street for a couple of years, and then a nun at the Catholic Church and Convent would take me to practice there.' Over time, Maxine grew to be a very accomplished pianist, keyboardist, and organist. She became the church's regular accompanist - playing on Sundays for the service, at weddings, funerals, and christenings. She was also asked to play at major events. such as accompanying Miss Australia, Tania Versak, in the 1960s and also the Harlem Globe Trotters in the 1980s. For many years she was also the accompanist for the Bridge Players, the Bridge Singers and other local plays and productions. Maxine married her husband Keith in 1964 and the couple had three daughters. Keith worked in insurance and was prominent in the community as the chairman of the church. Sadly, he died in 2019, 'Keith loved hearing me play,' Maxine says. These days, Maxine says her hands are a bit stiff, but she has enjoyed playing piano at some of the church services held at Resthaven. 'It's a very good way to exercise my brain,' Maxine says. 'I love playing all types of music, but obviously the songs I play at church are mostly religious songs. I do think the organ really shines with this type of music. You can feel the music inside you.' Thank you for sharing your story, Maxine.
