God is always with us.




In the Bible, soldiers would wear very heavy armour ready for battle. While Paul was in prison, he wrote a letter to the church.

Share how it is important for us to know the Bible to be ready for anything.



# **Dodgeball (with shields)**


In this version of dodgeball, we add shields which children can use to guard themselves. If the ball hits the shield they are not out.






# What to do:

Glue holding straps to back of shield. Wide enough for your child's arm.




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
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







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






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# Grossword Puzzle

#### CREATIVE RESPONSE

Draw or make a suit of armour out of heavy paper or cardboard and include the following pieces: belt, breastplate, shoes, shield, helmet and sword.

(With younger children you can use these items to play a game of "dress-up.").

Throughout the week, read the description of the "armour of God" in Ephesians 6:13-17. Note that this armor is not promoting violence but the "gospel of peace" (v.15).

Be aware of how the Holy One of God protects you with truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, and the Spirit and word of God. Take time to discuss what each part of the armour of God means to you.
